Every four years, organizations, community leaders, and residents come together for the CHNA to identify key health issues, determine priorities, and drive impactful change. The CHNA results guide funding decisions, community programs, and policy changes. Past assessments have influenced efforts in areas such as mental health services, substance use prevention, access to care, and food security. By participating, you can help ensure that resources are allocated to the issues that matter most to our community.
