Adult Primary Care: Our Adult Primary Care services offer comprehensive, patient-centered healthcare for individuals of all ages, from young adults to seniors. We provide a wide range of services, including preventive care, physical exams, immunizations, chronic disease management, lab services, and sick visits. Our team also offers specialized support such as nutrition counseling, diabetes education, and senior care. With a focus on personalized and proactive healthcare, we are dedicated to keeping you healthy at every stage of life. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information. Behavioral Health: Live Well Counseling, CHA Behavioral Health provides outpatient mental health services to anyone five years and older. We provide therapy to individuals, couples, and families to address trauma, anxiety, mood disorders, grief, relationships, increased stress, and parenting. We value access to care and will not allow cost to be a barrier to receiving services. We provide services to Cabarrus County and surrounding counties. We are currently offering in person sessions or virtual sessions. Virtual sessions are available for individuals that have camera access on their phone or computer. Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening: Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening -- Free breast exam, mammogram and PAP test for uninsured, income eligible women ages 40-64. Free breast exams and mammogram appointments for uninsured, income eligible women less than age 40 with breast problems. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointments and information. Residents of Cabarrus County only.

Early Childhood Care Management (CMARC): CMARC provides care management services to children birth to five years of age who have identified risks and **who meet** program criteria. CMARC care managers will focus on social, medical and developmental needs. Services may include assistance in making appointments, communicating with providers, making referrals, navigating child care options, community resources and programs, etc. For more information and referral call (704) 920-1189.

Communicable Disease Services: Investigation and education related to suspected cases of communicable disease including Tuberculosis (TB) for Cabarrus County residents. Call (704) 920-1218 for information.

Dental Health Services: Comprehensive dental care for the family. Dental Clinics located in Kannapolis and Concord. Call (704) 920-1070 for appointment and information. Medicaid, NC Health Choice, private insurance accepted. Sliding fee self-pay options available to Cabarrus County and Kannapolis City residents.

Environmental Health Services: Public pool Inspections, food establishment inspections, permitting for septic tank systems and individual drinking water wells and water testing. Call (704) 920-1207 for information.

Family Planning Services: Exams, lab work, birth control education and birth control methods for women and men. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information. Medicaid/Medicare and most Private Insurance plans accepted, sliding fee discount options available.

Harm Reduction Services: People who inject drugs are at risk for HIV, Hepatitis B virus (HBV) and Hepatitis C virus (HCV) infection through sharing needles and drug-preparation equipment. (This is because sharing needles or works like spoons, cottons, ties, or water can transfer blood from person to person.) Also, when you're high on drugs, you're more likely to take risks with sex, which can increase your risk for getting HIV. You can get: Sterile supplies, condoms along with other safer sex supplies, and Sharps containers for the disposal of needles. We also offer free disposal of used needles, provide free Naloxone (Narcan) medication, and FREE HIV & Hep C testing every Wednesday with no appointment needed. All these services are provided by a peer with lived experiences and provides peer support services. The Hepatitis C Bridge Program: Provides screening and testing for (HCV) infections and facilitates linkages to care and treatment for people who are infected with HCV. The HCV Bridge Counselor assigned to patients will provide disease specific patient education and track the patient at specific milestones throughout the treatment cascade. HIV Testing/Counseling: Walk-in free HIV testing and counseling is available without an appointment Monday through Friday, 8 am –11:30am and 1pm - 4 pm.

Immunizations: State required immunizations available for children from birth through age 18. Adult immunizations are also available. Bring immunization record to appointment. Most private insurance plans accepted. Qualifications for state vaccines will be assessed. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information.

International Travel Immunizations: Consultation and immunizations provided for foreign travel. Charges vary based on vaccines given. Call (704) 920-1231 for an appointment and information.

Laboratory Services : Family studies for Sickle Cell and blood lead testing/follow-up. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information.

Maternity Services: Routine and High-Risk care for pregnant women. Ultrasound, Lab, Fetal Monitoring, Mental Health Services and Nutritional Counseling. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information. Medicaid/Medicare and most Private Insurance plans accepted. Sliding fee discount program options available for residents of Cabarrus County or Kannapolis City only.

Pediatric Services: Routine, well-child checkups, primary care & immunizations along with integrated nutrition, dental, and behavioral health services. Office hours are Monday-Friday 8 am - 5 pm. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information. Medicaid/Medicare and most private insurance plans accepted. Sliding fee discount program options available for well-child checkups for residents of Cabarrus County or Kannapolis City only.

Pregnancy Care Management (CMHRP): CMHRP services focus on coordinating care and services for pregnant women who have identified risk factors. Services may include: assistance in making appointments, communication with providers, making referrals, navigating community resources and programs, etc. For more information and referral call (704) 920-1189 and information.

Pregnancy Testing Available: Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information. Medicaid/Medicare and most private insurance plans accepted.

School Health: The Cabarrus Health Alliance School Health Program started with a "nurse in every school" in 1999. Registered, public health nurses employed by the Cabarrus Health Alliance provide school health services in each traditional elementary, middle, and high school in Cabarrus County Schools and Kannapolis City Schools. Nurses are also assigned to provide nursing oversight and consultation for non-traditional schools in these districts. Please call 704-920-1132 for more information.

The RISE Clinic: The RISE Clinic provides comprehensive services for treating individuals with Opioid Use Disorder. Services include Buprenorphine treatment, Peer Support Services, Counseling services all at low or no cost to individuals without insurance or with limited insurance. Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Services: Testing, treatment and education for persons suspected of having a sexually transmitted disease. HIV Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (or PrEP) assessment appointments available. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information.

The SUN Clinic: If you are pregnant and have concerns with substance use disorder or are interested in getting connected for Suboxone treatment, please contact the SUN Clinic at 704-920-1289. The SUN clinic offers obstetrical services, Ultrasound, nutrition, mental health and substance use counseling, peer support services and connection to various community partners who are committed to supporting pregnant women in sustaining recovery and delivering healthy babies.

TB Testing: Client must return in 48-72 hours for reading of skin test. QuantiFERON Gold testing is also available. Call (704) 920-1205 for appointment and information.

Vital Records: Deputy Registrar processes certificates for all deaths and births that occur in Cabarrus County. Call 704-920-1329 for assistance.

WIC: Supplemental food and nutrition education program for eligible pregnant or postpartum women, infants, and children up to age 5. Breastfeeding information available. Call (704) 920-1204 for appointment and information. Open to residents of any county within NC.
